



## Alice Hutchison Little

August 30, 1926 - June 18, 2017

Alice Hutchison Little, lifelong resident of Crystal Springs, Mississippi, died on June 18, 2017. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, June 20, 2017, from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. at Stringer Funeral Home in Crystal Springs. Funeral services will be on Wednesday, June 21, at 2:00 p.m. at First Presbyterian Church in Crystal Springs with visitation beginning at 1:00 p.m. Burial will follow the service at Crystal Springs City Cemetery.

Mrs. Little was born on August 30, 1926, to Fountain M. Hutchison and Mamie Bell Hutchison. She grew up as a member of the Crystal Springs United Methodist Church and graduated from Crystal Springs High School in 1944. She attended Belhaven College then worked in Jackson for the Robinson and Julienne Insurance Agency.

On February 14, 1954, she married Dr. James Earl Little, Jr. at the Crystal Springs United Methodist Church. She assisted her husband with bookkeeping in his dental practice for forty-one years.

After her marriage, Mrs. Little became an active member of First Presbyterian Church of Crystal Springs. She taught Sunday School for over fifty years and was an integral part of the service rendered by the Women of the Church, serving in several officer positions.

One of her biggest joys was conducting ministry to the women at the Copiah

County Detention Center.

Mrs. Little was a member of the Copiah County Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution and cherished her membership in the Crystal Springs Garden Club where she garnered many blue ribbons at flower shows for her beautiful arrangements. She enjoyed traveling to all fifty states as well as many trips to various parts of Europe.

She was preceded in death by her parents and brother, Col. Fountain M. Hutchison, Jr.

She is survived by her husband of sixty-three years, Dr. James E. Little, two daughters, Laura Little Westmoreland of Crystal Springs and Susan Little Risher of Brandon, MS, grandchildren Steven Paul Westmoreland, Jr., Wade James Westmoreland, and John Colburn Westmoreland, all of Crystal Springs, Alice Kennedy Risher Norwood and Margaret Michelle Risher Bracey, both of Jackson, MS, and Virginia Carol Risher of New Orleans, LA, and also her sister-in-law Imogene M. Hutchison of Columbus, MS. She is also survived by four great-granddaughters and a host of nieces and nephews.
