July 20, 1926 - March 17, 2025

Arva Lee Sharp, of Crystal Springs, died on March 17, 2025 at Copiah Living Center. She was 98.

Mrs. Sharp was a native of Crystal Springs, having been born to Gladys and Clifton Johnson on July 20, 1926. She graduated from Crystal Springs Consolidated High School in 1945, and spent most of her life in Crystal Springs as a homemaker. She was a member of First Baptist Church of Crystal Springs, where she sang in the Golden Choir. She was a member of the Copiah Chapter Daughters of the American Revolution, a direct descendant of the Revolutionary War veteran Daniel Johnson, who settled in Copiah County.
