Charles Vernon Bland, 78, passed away June 6, 2014 at his residence. Visitation will be 5pm-8pm Sunday at Stringer Family Funeral Home in Hazlehurst. Mr. Bland owned and operated Charles Bland Dozer Service for 30 years. Many house sites were prepared, and numerous ponds in the area were attributed to his work, of which he was very proud. In his later years Mr. Bland raised and trained Catahoula Cur dogs. Survivors include son, Charles Dalton Bland and wife Nanette, two granddaughters, Megan Bland of Washington, D.C., Tristin Bland of Wesson, and numerous cousins.
