David Lyn Gribble passed away on Wednesday, May 24, 2023, at the age of 49.

Born September 17, 1973, to Earl David Breeden and Linda Henderson in Dalton, Georgia, David grew up in Maryville, Tennessee. In Maryville, he later operated a residential contracting business for a number of years.

David moved in 2016 to Crystal Springs, Mississippi, where he and his wife Kristen were married.
