Everette Lee Conley, 87, passed away at the Mississippi Veterans Home in Collins November 2, 2024. Visitation will be 1pm-2pm Monday at Stringer Family Funeral Home in Crystal Springs. The service will be 2pm Monday at Stringer Family Chapel with burial at County Line Cemetery.

Mr. Conley was an avid gardener, both vegetables and flowers, and enjoyed woodworking. Prior to health issues he could often be seen building birdhouses and other items at local events such as the Tomato Festival in Crystal Springs or the parking lots of local markets.

He served honorable in the USAF as a security officer at Lincoln AFB in Nebraska, often talking about how cold it was there compared to Mississippi.
