



## Rev. Floyd Ashpole

Rev. Floyd Ashpole, 94, passed away at his home October 29, 2021. Visitation will be Wednesday from 10am-11am at Stringer Family Funeral Home in Crystal Springs. The funeral service will be 11am Wednesday at Stringer Family Chapel.
