James Larry "Larry" Davis, age 76, passed away on March 31, 2026, at his home in Crystal Springs, Mississippi. The service will be 11am Friday, April 3, 2026, at First Baptist Church, Crystal Springs, with burial at Gallman Cemetery. The visitation will begin on Friday at 9am at the church. 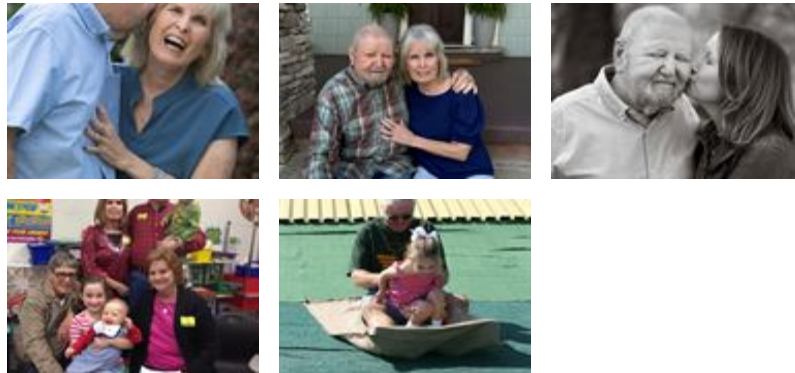
