Janice Sanderson Huntington, 83, passed away Friday, March 3, in Hazlehurst.

Mrs. Huntington was born in Hazlehurst on January 5, 1934 to the late Tom & Ruth Sanderson.

She had the rare accomplishment of scoring a hole-in-one on Hole #3. She hit the ball true & straight, didn't know what the "rough" was and could putt your eyes out on the greens. She and her buddies travelled the state playing women's golf tournaments. When she could no longer swing a club, she was often watching a golfing event on television.

She was sweet, quick with a witty line and loved to laugh. She loved people and easily made friends from all walks of life. She will be very much missed. She is survived by her children: David T. Huntington (Kim) of Hazlehurst, Jenny H. Branston (John) of Memphis, and John W. Huntington (Jim) of Jackson, and grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her sister, Nancy Sanderson Harris (Alton) and her brother, Tommy Sanderson (Janice Sue).
