Judith Randle Brewer, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother and friend, passed away peacefully surrounded by her family at her home in Hazlehurst, MS on November 6, 2024. Judith was born on June 1, 1940 in Fair Hope Springs, MS. She was preceded in death by her parents, the late Ellis Eugene Randle and Lucille Myrick Randle.

Judith was a graduate of Hazlehurst High School. She furthered her education at the University of Southern Mississippi, where she obtained both bachelor's and master's degrees in music. Judith first worked with the Columbia City School District, where she used her talents to teach Choral Music. She was an accomplished pianist and was honored to travel with the United States of America High School Chorus as their choral director. Following a move to Clinton, MS, Judith attended Mississippi College, where she obtained a specialist degree in Education. She served as an administrator for Clinton Public Schools for over 35 years until her retirement.

Following her retirement, Judith and her husband moved back to Hazlehurst where she was raised. She was an active member of First Baptist Church Hazlehurst where she taught her beloved Vota Vita Sunday School class and sang in the church choir. Judith loved her book club and Daughters of the American Revolution. She also maintained a close relationship with a special group of teachers from her time as Principal at Lovett Elementary in Clinton.

Judith is survived by her husband of 65 years, Dr. Jim Brewer, daughter Lisa Brewer Scruggs (Mark), grandsons Randle Scruggs (Emily) of Nashville, TN and Joshua Scruggs (Rachel) of Athens, TN, and great grandchildren, Ellie, Laney and Leo Scruggs.
