



Reeves Beasley

November 28, 1942 - July 28, 2024

Willard Reeves Beasley, known affectionately as "RB," passed away on July 28, 2024, in Jackson, Mississippi, at the age of 81. Born on November 28, 1942, in Hazlehurst, Mississippi, RB lived a life marked by dedication to his family, friends and community.

RB worked on the railroad as a locomotive engineer in the 70s and 80s and also served in the National Guard, where he committed himself to the values of duty and service. After retiring, he embarked on a career that saw him owning and operating RB's One Stop and 3B's Auto Sales which showcased his entrepreneurial spirit and strong work ethic.

A member of the Hazlehurst Methodist Church, RB's faith was a cornerstone of his life. He was a man of simple pleasures, one of which was his love for cows which reflected his deep appreciation for the simpler, rural lifestyle.

RB created a beautiful life with his wife of 61 years, Eloise Beasley. Together, they raised three daughters and were blessed with six grandchildren and a great-granddaughter. preceded in death by his parents, Florence and Lawrence Beasley, and daughter Angela Beasley Adams.
