A Graveside services will be 2:30pm Monday at Sandtown Cemetery in Philadelphia, MS. After attending East Central Community College, Rev. Burton served in the Army. At the end of his military service, Rev. Burton returned to ECCC and then attended Ole Miss, graduating with a degree in business. While serving churches in Chatsworth, GA, he received a Master of Divinity from Emory University. During his ministry, Rev. Burton served the following churches: Winona First, Mineral Wells, Sledge, Moorhead, Amory-St. Andrews, Leland, Belzoni First, Southaven, Rolling Fork and Crystal Springs. After retiring, Rev. Burton continued to preach at Gallman and Bethesda. Rev. Burton was the pastor when churches were built in Winona and Crystal Springs, and a new parsonage was built in Moorhead. Also, under his leadership, construction began on a church in Amory and a new congregation was organized in Southaven. Rev. Burton loved the Lord, the church and his family. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Amber Fay Burton; five children, Belinda French (Jim) of Meridian, MS, Dan Burton (Diane) of Lexa, AR, Don Burton (Felecia) of Oxford, MS, Elizabeth Gallagher (Bryan) of Alexandria, AL, Vanessa Stewart (Squeaky) of Orange Beach, AL; 18 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren. He is also survived by two brothers,
