Sammy Don Myers, 84, passed away Wednesday, August 14, 2013, in Oxford, MS with his daughters by his side. He had recently become a resident of the Mississippi State Veterans Home in Oxford. He was born April 2, 1929 to the late Clell and Lucille (Pursor) Myers and grew up in Hazlehurst, MS. He graduated from Mississippi State University with a BS in Agricultural Engineering. He served as an officer in the U.S. Army for 22 years, retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel. He served in the Korean and Vietnam Wars. Following his military service, he then returned to Mississippi, residing in Clinton and working for the State of Mississippi at the Classification Commission (now the Personnel Board) and the Department of Agriculture and Commerce. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Clinton. After his retirement he constructed his dream home on family property near Hazlehurst, where he was a member of Bethel Baptist Church. He is survived by his loving wife, Ruby Lynn Beall, the sweetheart of his youth. They were happily married for 62 years. He is also survived by his daughters, Dona Kaufman (Alan) of Germantown, MD and Lee Slenker (Jeff) of Memphis, TN, his brother, Dean Myers of Hazlehurst, MS and his grandson, Carter Kaufman of Bel Air, MD.
