One of "The Greatest Generation," W. L. Berry of Hazlehurst, passed away on June 29, 2013. He was 93. W. L. was born in Georgetown, MS, the son of Willie E. and Lelia Berry, and was a graduate of Georgetown High School. He served in the U. S. Army Quartermaster Service in the European theater, attaining the rank of Staff Sergeant.
